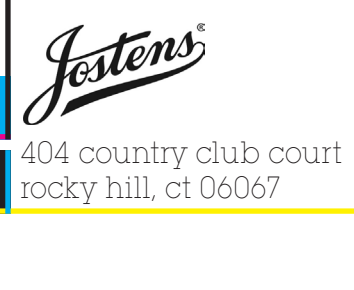
SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

ESSENTIAL INFO

Plan to arrive at the Bryant University campus for registration and room assignments between 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM on Monday, June 26th. Classes will start promptly at 9:30 that morning. The workshop will end Tuesday, June 27th by 3:00 PM.

Adviser attendance is strongly encouraged. Student effort and interest is far greater when advisers attend with students. We do require an adviser/chaperone to help guide a larger group (5 or more students).

Be sure to bring copies of your 2016 & 2017 yearbooks. We will have our annual **book swap** to help you add to your sample library. Bring a book, take a book home!

HOUSING

Students will be housed in double occupancy rooms in a suite with a total of four rooms. You may be housed with students from other schools. Men and women are housed on separate floors. Advisers have single rooms, also part of a larger suite of four rooms. Dorm chaperones will be on duty throughout the night.

University campus security will be on duty in the dormitories during the night hours for protection and to enforce non-visitation rules. Any violation of the rules and regulations of the Summer Yearbook Workshop or Bryant University will result in an immediate dismissal from the workshop. All dorms are air-conditioned and linens will be provided. Bring a blanket or sleeping bag, your favorite pillow, your yearbook ideas and an open mind!
